

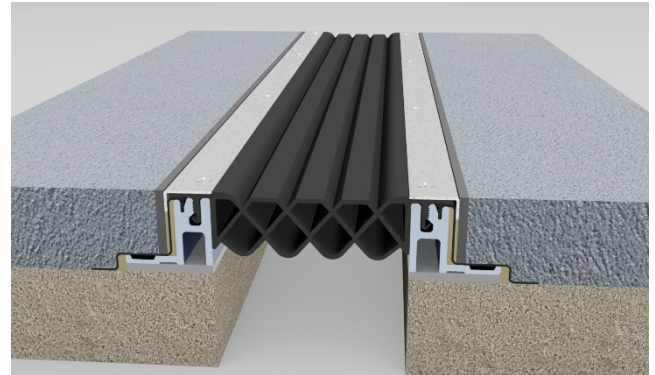

The Wabo®WaterTite system combines a choice of versatile elastomeric seals for variable joint openings and system heights to accommodate split slab construction.

- Structures where water tightness is essential, such as areas over occupied spaces.

PACKAGING/COVERAGE:

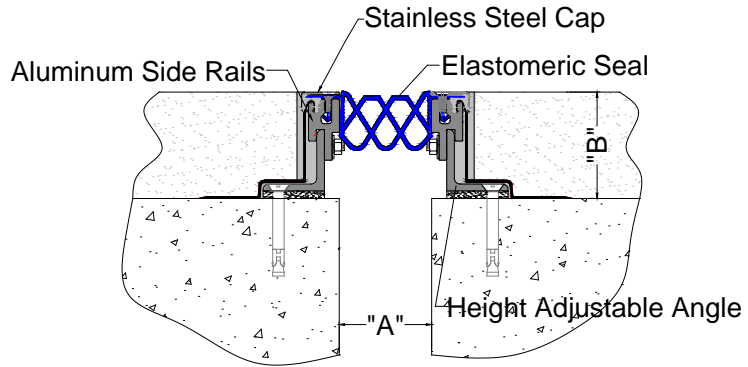
- Aluminum Rail is shipped in 10 foot lengths on a pallet.
- Elastomeric Seal is shipped in continuous lengths.
- Hardware is packaged in cartons as required.

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APPLICATION:

INSTALLATION SUMMARY:

- The joint opening must be abrasive blasted to remove all latencies and contaminants which may cause bonding problems. The joint opening should be blown clean using compressed air (>90psi).
- Structural concrete to be leveled using a high strength, high flow epoxy grout.
- Use anchoring devices and fasteners for securing expansion joint assembly in place.
- Perform all cutting and fitting required for installation of expansion joint system.
- Maintain continuity of expansion joint assembly and properly align all metal members.
- Integrate flashing sheet with deck waterproofing system materials. Install elastomeric seals in continuous lengths.
- WaboWaterTite must be installed per WBA Installation Procedure.

FOR BEST RESULTS:

- Install when concrete substrate is clean, sound, dry, and cured (14 day minimum).
- Do not allow any of the components to freeze prior to installation. Store all components out of direct sunlight in a clean, dry location between 50°F and 90°F. Do not store in high humidity.
- Do not install if the joint's anticipated movement will exceed the system's movement range.
- Protect the work area with appropriate plastic sheeting.
- Minimize splice points by installing seals in longest possible continuous lengths.
- Periodically inspect the applied material and repair localized areas as needed. Consult a Watson Bowman Acme representative for additional information.
